

FLIP YOUR CLASSROOM

Ensure students have access to the appropriate technology required.

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Set expectations about:

- Time commitments required outside of the classroom.
- How and when students will be assessed.

Flipping Is...

Thoughtfully structured and planned content instruction that allows for more in-depth exploration and practice of learned skills inside the classroom

Flipping Is Not...

Having students watch a video in place of a traditional lecture
