# Using the NCII Lesson Plans at Home: Tips for Parents

## What are NCII lesson plans?

The National Center on Intensive Intervention provides free lesson plans that can be used at home to provide your child with extra practice in <u>reading</u> and <u>math</u> skills. ### How do I use them?

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Talk to your child's teacher about which lesson plan to use.

**Review the lesson plan** to become familiar with the instructions, materials, and scripts.

- **3** Prepare the materials needed to deliver the lesson.
  - Print out the included resources, find items around your home, or use your hands for demonstrations.
  - **Deliver the instruction** as outlined in the lesson plan. [Follow the script!]

#### **Tips for success!**

- Don't expect perfection at first. Delivery gets easier over time.
- Keep sessions short and distribute practice throughout the day. Set aside 5-10 minutes at a time.
- Focus on repetition! Your child will need multiple opportunities to respond and receive feedback.
- Share challenges and progress with your child's teacher.


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
